Scholarship Opportunities sponsored by the NJMCA:

### **College Scholarship \$500 available**

- The applicant must be or have been a full time high school student in good standing for the most recent school year.
- The student must be accepted to attend a college or university and have an interest in engaging in studies that may benefit the mosquito control community.
- The applicant must have a family member or sponsor who is an active member of the New Jersey Mosquito Control Association.

### **Educational Scholarship \$1,000 available**

- The applicant must be a full time matriculating student in an accredited college or university in New Jersey.
- The student must be conducting (or recently have completed) research that contributes new information to the mosquito control community.

### **Daniel M. Jobbins Scholarship \$4,000 available**

- The applicant must be a full time matriculating student in an accredited graduate program.
- The student must be conducting (or recently have completed) research regarding mosquitoes, their biology and/or practical control.
