Scholarships are awarded to students that have been impacted by organ and tissue donation and transplantation and/or are advocates for our life-saving mission. The deadline for submission is Friday, March 20, 2020 at noon. Please note the amount of each scholarship and the number of awardees will be determined in March during the application review process.

Since the enactment of the Hero Act in 2008, each public high school must provide information about organ and tissue donation and transplantation in their Core Curriculum Content Standards for Comprehensive Health and Physical Education for grades 9-12. To assist schools in meeting this requirement, we provide a free, comprehensive program, with trained speakers and materials, to help students make an informed decision about donation and encourage them to share their wishes with their families and friends.

Year after year, the number of high school students reached through our program continues to grow. In 2019 – 2020 alone, over 40,000 students were educated about donation and transplantation.
