You were previously notified that the Mercer County Technical School District would be closed until March 27, 2020. However, Governor Phil Murphy recently issued an Executive Order closing schools indefinitely. In compliance with the directive, the Mercer County Technical School District will be closed through April 19, 2020, pending approval from the Governor to reopen.

Please be advised that our food service operations has been revised and will continue. As of today, Grab and Go, Breakfast and Lunch meals, can be picked up on Mondays and Thursdays as follows:

- Assunpink Center students from 11:30 am – 1:00 pm pick up at MCSSSD's Mercer High School (Main entrance bus stop) at 1020 Old Trenton Road, Hamilton, NJ 08690
- Sypek Center and Rubino Academy students from 12:30 pm – 1:30 pm pick up at Sypek Center's Building A, 129 Bull Run Road, Pennington, NJ 08534

Please note that we will not be distributing food during the regularly scheduled spring break (April 10 to 17). Three (3) meals will be provided during the Thursday, April 9th distribution.

Due to school closures, we must continue our transition to eLearning. Teachers and staff will continue providing new lessons and resources through the district's website and our other digital platforms.
